

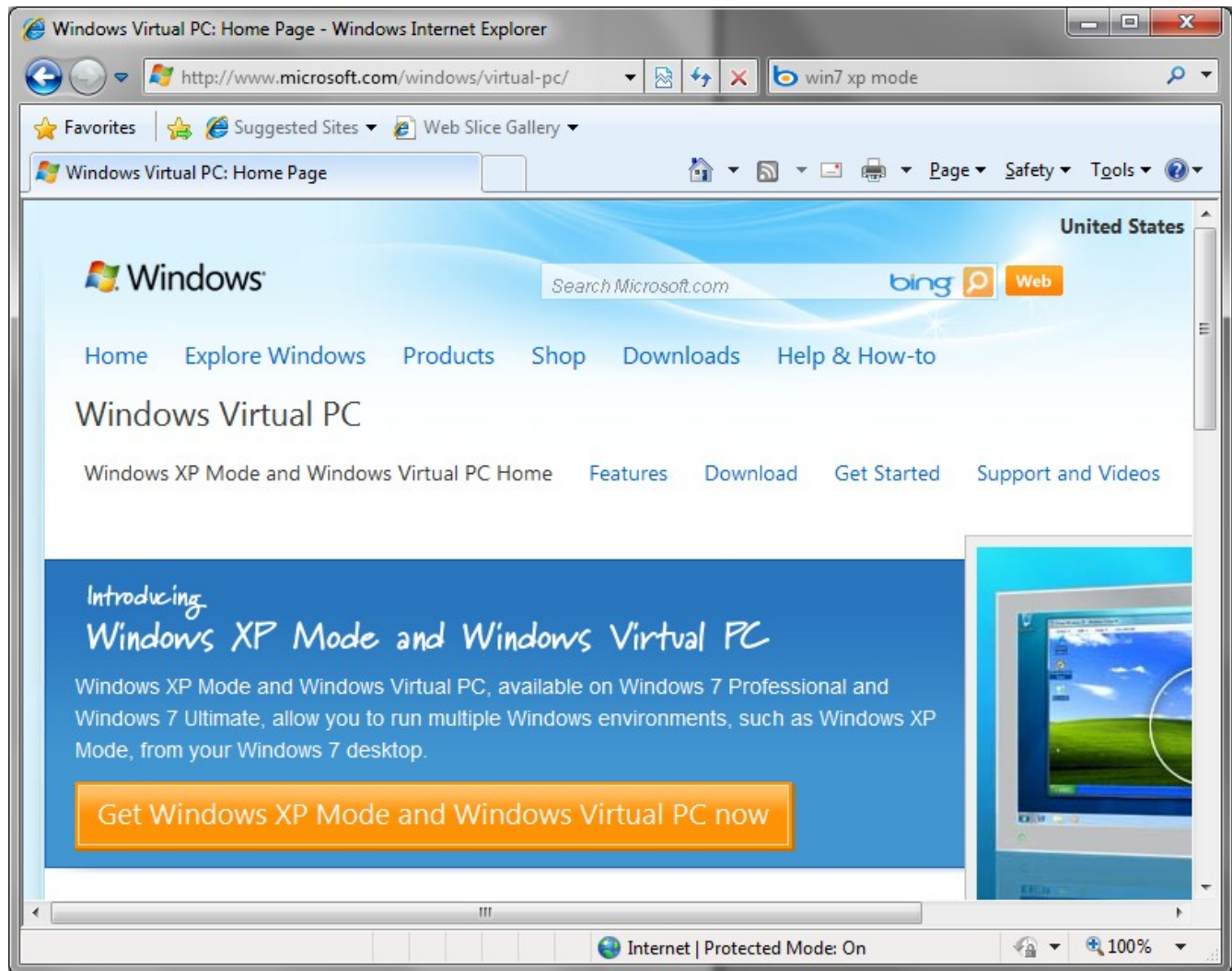
Installing Visimage on Windows 7 64bit XP Mode

(XP Mode is not available for Windows 7 Home Premium 64bit.)

Step 1). Download and Install XP Mode

Browse to <http://www.microsoft.com/windows/virtual-pc/>

Depending on when you are reading this document the link “Get Windows XP Mode and Windows Virtual PC now” should be available.



If the link has been removed from the Virtual PC home page, try this link :

STEP 1 **Do I need Windows XP Mode?**
Windows 7 has several built-in tools to help with **application compatibility** and Windows XP applications should be installed directly on Windows 7. Windows XP Mode runs some older productivity applications that may not run otherwise on Windows 7.

STEP 2 **Can my PC run Windows XP Mode?**
Check that your PC hardware works with Windows XP Mode by downloading and running this **tool**.

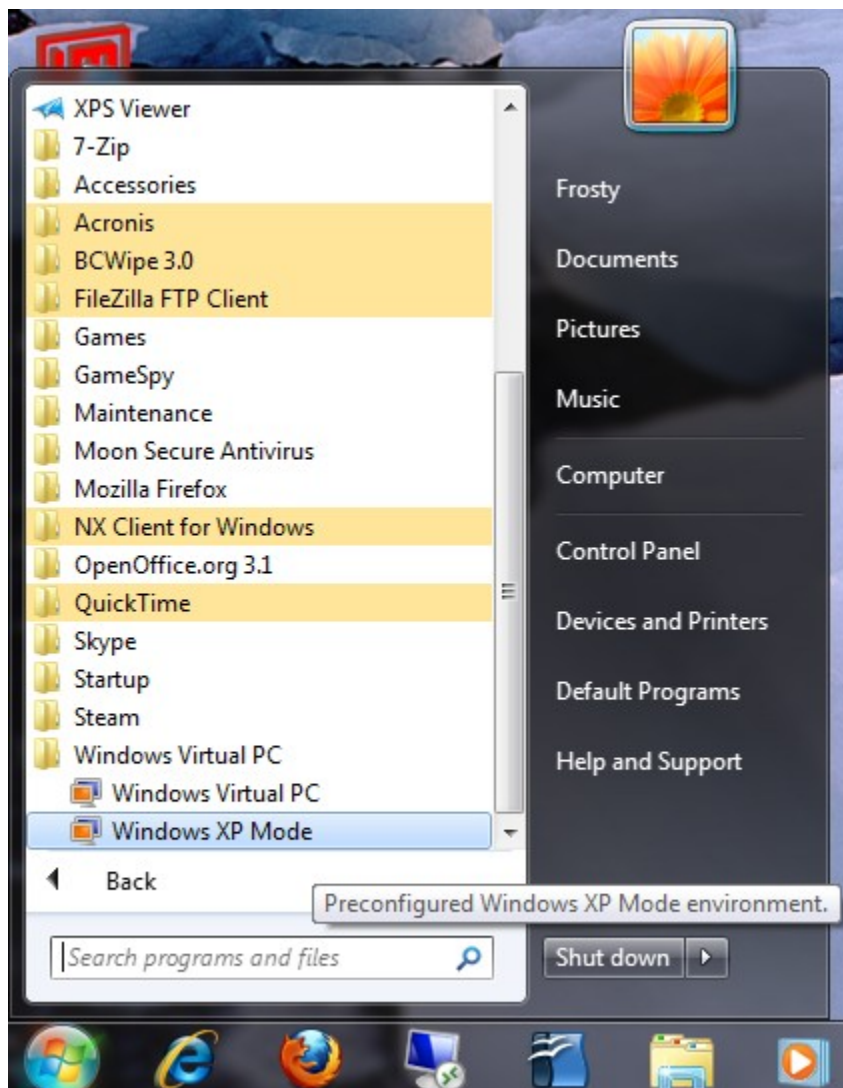
STEP 3 **Select your edition of Windows 7 and desired language for installation in Step 3**
Select system Select language

STEP 4 **Download and install Windows XP Mode**
Windows XP Mode requires downloading and installing **both** of the files below.

Check that your PC's hardware works with Windows XP Mode by downloading and running the tool in Step 2.

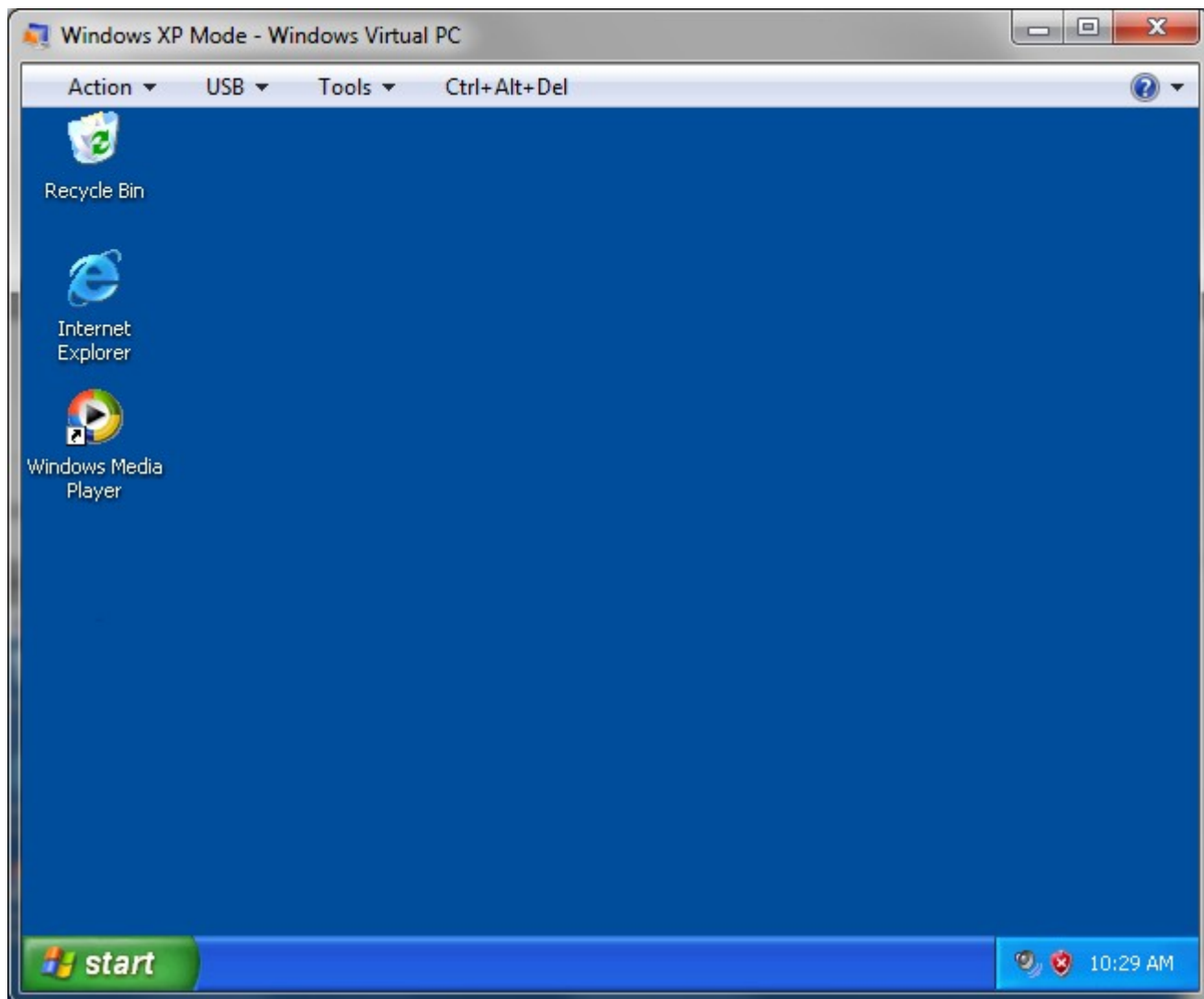
Internet | Protected Mode: On 100%

Once XP Mode and Virtual PC have been installed, you should find an option for Windows XP Mode within the Windows Virtual PC start menu folder.



Select Windows XP Mode to begin configuring your virtual machine.

Once your XP Mode environment is configured you should have an XP desktop available on the screen.



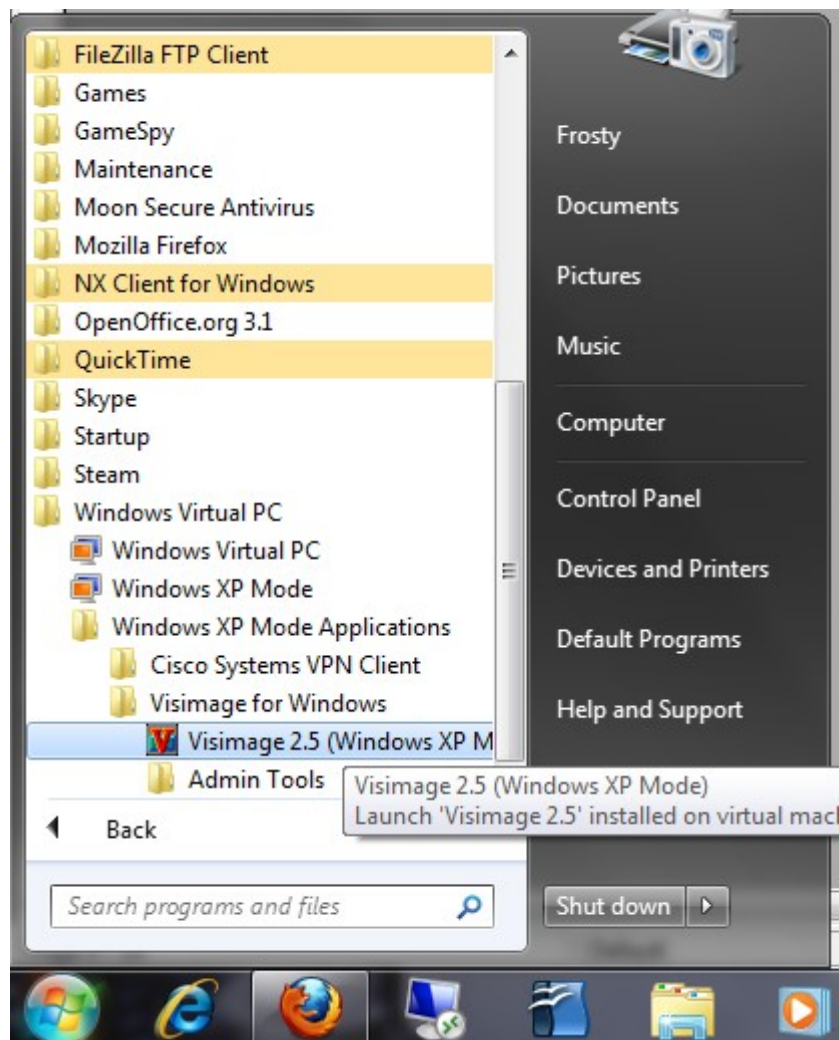
Step 2). Download and Install Visimage

Within the XP Mode virtual machine, download and install the latest version of Visimage from our website:

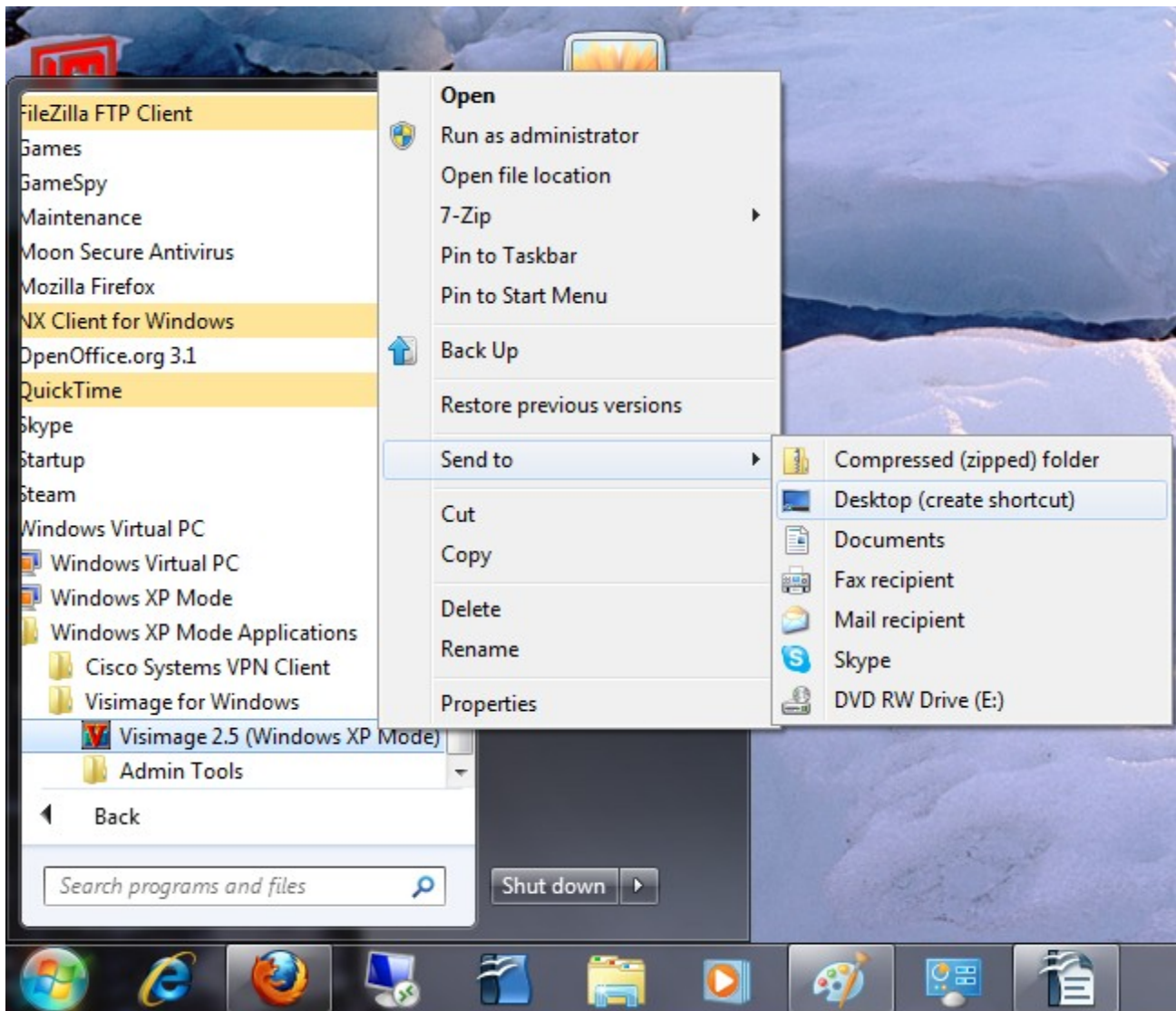

Once Visimage has been installed, there should be a new link available on the 64bit host's Start Menu as shown here:

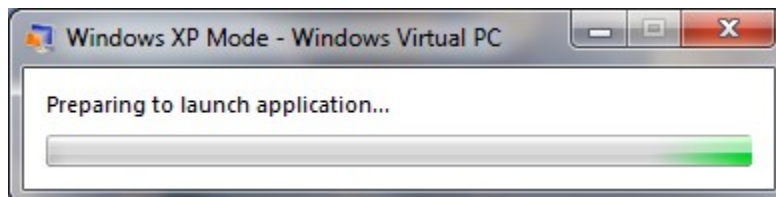


Create a shortcut, on your 64bit host's desktop, to the newly installed Visimage program.

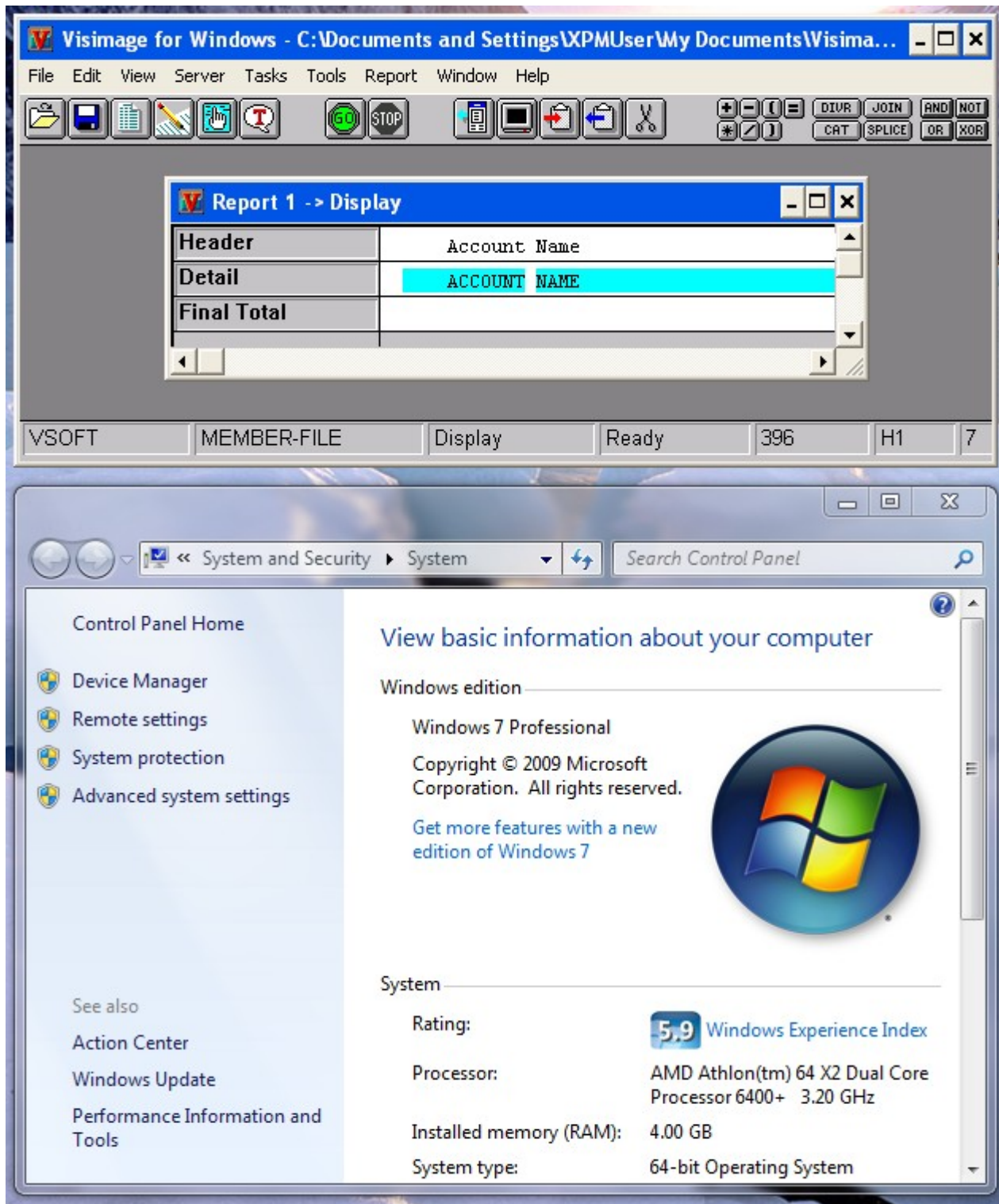


Open Visimage using the newly created shortcut on your 64bit host's desktop.

You will see this screen while XP Mode loads, preparing to launch Visimage.



Visimage should load, running in the Windows 7 foreground.
